	DESCRIPTION:	An outdoor 8 lane, 50 Mtr pool. Normal temperature 30 Winter and 28 Summer. Depth is a consistent 1.066 Mtrs.	
	USE:	This pool is used predominately for lane swimming and swim squad people. Other activities can include Kayak training and Scuba Diving training as well as some supervised school groups.	
	RISK ASSESSMENT:	Highest risk group in this pool are the elderly early morning swimmers and unsupervised children. Risky behaviour includes: running around perimeter of pool, bombing, dangerous diving, fighting, bullying or any misuse of equipment.	
	PHYSICAL HAZARDS:	Ice on concrete on frosty mornings.	
	LIFEGUARDING POLICY:	1 Lifeguard required at all times Number of patrons before additional Lifeguard required is 70. Additional lifeguards not anticipated for this pool. This pool can be life guarded in conjunction with the outdoor spas during quiet periods. If there is a need for the lifeguard to leave the pool area they must be relieved by another qualified person.	
<u>Indoor 32m Pool</u>			
	DESCRIPTION:	Indoor 32m Pool, 8 Lanes with moveable bulkhead. Normal temperatures range 30-31 degrees. Temperature may be lowered for competitions. Depth 1.9m on the side to 2m in the middle.	
	USE:	Anticipate that this pool will be used for aqua jogging, competitive and lane swimming, water polo, canoe polo and under water hockey. It may be used for scuba training also, but this will be confined to the bulkhead area where possible.	
	RISK ASSESSMENT:	Weak swimmers will be at risk in this pool, this group could include the elderly or very young and those with special needs.	
	PHYSICAL HAZARDS:	Depth of water, slippery pool surrounds and the misuse of equipment.	
	LIFEGUARDING POLICY:	Minimum of 1 lifeguard eyes on pool at all times. Number of patrons before additional lifeguards are required is 70. More lifeguards will be introduced if aquatic leisure equipment is in use. This pool may be life guarded in conjunction with the Learner Pool during quiet periods.	

Indoor Learner Pool

DESCRIPTION:	Indoor learner pool temperature range is 33.5-34.5 degrees. Can be raised for special occasions. The depth varies from 0 in the beach area to a maximum of 0.9 mars.
USE:	This pool will attract all user groups but predominately younger patrons. This pool is also used for the swim school classes.
RISK ASSESSMENT:	Young children out of their depth, boisterous teenagers, bombing, dangerous diving or misuse of equipment.
PHYSICAL HAZARDS:	Sloping floor from beach area, slippery pool surrounds any added aquatic leisure equipment.

LIFEGUARDING POLICY:	One lifeguard on duty al all times, additional lifeguard required when
	numbers exceed 80. This pool may be life guarded in conjunction with
	the Deep pool and/or indoor spas during quiet periods.

<u>Spa Pools</u>

DESCRIPTION:	4 Pools, temperature range 37 - 39 degrees. Pools have a maximum depth of 0.8m.
USE:	Predominately used by adult patrons with a minimum age of 8. Users under 8 are to be accompanied by a responsible caregiver 16 and over.
RISK ASSESSMENT:	Moving water and temperature.
PHYSICAL HAZARDS:	Steps to pools, slippery wet floors.
LIFEGUARDING POLICY:	Areas lifeguarded when in use.

<u>Lazy River</u>

DESCRIPTION:	25 mtr long circuitous pool with a maximum depth of 0.9 mtr and a temperature range of 35-37 degrees. With a current moving at 0.5 mtrs per second
USE:	All user groups with a minimum age of 8. Users under 8 are to be accompanied by a responsible caregiver 16 and over.
RISK ASSESSMENT:	Moving water, temperature and misuse of Lazy River.
PHYSICAL HAZARDS:	Steps to pools, slippery wet floors, blind spots behind central island,.
LIFEGUARDING POLICY:	Area lifeguarded when in use
