| i. Slip and fall areas | All pathways and access areas are well maintained and signage is used where applicable. |
| ii. Agrichemicals, pesticides etc. | All chemicals and pesticides are stored away from complex and locked up in cupboard with appropriate signage. |
| iii. Agriculture, tools & equipment | Stored and located in area which is not accessible to customers. |
| iv. Contact with livestock used for sheep show | All animals are selected with considerable care, for temperament and health. Regular veterinary checks are carried out through the year. |
| v. General site safety | Company maintains regular inspection of complex and implements the codes of practise within the health and safety policies. |
| vi. Farm Tour plant and equipment | All vehicles used for farm tours have safety procedures in place including: tractor check lists done daily, rated towing vehicles, first aid boxes equipped in all tractors, emergency pull cords to warn driver.

- 4) Students will be invited after the show to visit the parade of rams on stage and we ask this to happen in an orderly fashion. Assistance must be provided by an adult supervisor.
