**School Visit Protocols**

**Adult/Pupil supervision ratio**

(a) Primary and secondary school aged students (to 16yrs old)  
1 adult per 7 students.

(b) Students 17 yrs and over

Please ensure you supply adequate supervisory staff. We recommend 1 adult to 10 students

**Safety while on the Walk**

**Please stay on the formed paths at all times. These are clearly marked.**

- Please obey the instructions of our Guide. If you choose to not use the services of our guide then the safety information is on page one of the Walking tour guidesheet.

**Safety while on the Boat**

**Please read the safety information on page one of the Boat Guidesheet.**

**Obey the instructions of the Captain at all times**

- Do not go onto the front deck without the Boat Captains approval
- Ensure children are supervised at all times
- Stay inside the Boat handrails at all times
- Take care when moving around the boat
- Report any concerns to the Captain as soon as possible

**Environment**

- Plants must not be picked or harmed on any way
- No samples of any type maybe collected
- No stones or sticks to be thrown
- Geothermal features must not be broken, walked on, dug, scratched or damaged in any way.
- Graffiti is unacceptable
- Collect and deposit all rubbish in the bins provided

**Food**

Please note that it will not be possible to use our café facility for eating food brought to Waimangu.

If you want to bring your own food to Waimangu then we will organise the use of one of our picnic areas down in the valley.
